

SPRING BLACK BEAR HUNT GEAR LIST

Welcome to your floating base camp aboard the M/V Emydon. We look forward to touching some untamed places with you. To ensure your enjoyment we encourage you to go through this gear list and make sure that you have everything that is needed before we head out into the rugged wilderness..

Note: Average Temperature Range is 40-70 °F and wet.



WE PROVIDE:

Bedding, towels for showering as well as all the meals aboard and ashore.

YOU PROVIDE:

- Neoprene Ankel Fit Hip Boots. You'll want a pair of Frog Togg Rain Paints taht you can cut off at the knees. This will keep your rear dry during heavy rain. (The hip boots that I recommend are called Alaska Tuff's. You can mail order them from Juneau Western Auto & Marine 907-780-4909.
- OR -
- Simms G3 or G4 "Stocking Foot" Waist Waders: with vibram soled wading shoes. (No felts allowed) This is a comfortable, although more expensive, weather proof option. Make sure that you don't bring other Gore-Tex waders, as they tend to be too loud for hunting. (www.simms-fishing.com)
- Shooting Sticks: Shots average 150 yds.
- 60 Rounds Ammo with bonded bullets. (Swift, Trophy Bonded Bear Claw, Barnes Triple Shock, etc.)
- 30 Cal. Magnum or Larger with good scope for low light. Average shot 40 yds.
- Scope covers and spare. (Especially when bringing bikini or sleeve style that may be lost.)
- Fenix 1,000-1,500 Lumen Headlamp with spare batteries and a spare Fenix headlamp. (www.fenixlighting.com)
- Excellent waterproof/quiet hunting coat. (Sitka, Kuiu, Grundens, Swazi, etc.)
- Waterproof cap and gloves, 2 sets clothes, 2 sets merino wool or silk long johns
- Quiet day pack. (Simms, Kuiu, Sitka, etc.)
- Binoculars 7-10x
- Optional: Camera, Satellite Phone, INREACH, GPS, Spot Tracker, Etc.
- Boat Slippers (To keep you feet dry and warm on the base camp boat.)
- Water Bottle
