

# FLY FISHING GEAR LIST

Welcome to your floating base camp aboard M/V Emydon. We look forward to touching some untamed fishing grounds with you. To ensure your enjoyment we encourage you to go through this gear list and make sure that you have what is needed before we hit those salmon filled rivers together!



## WE PROVIDE:

Bedding, towels for showering, flies and leaders, as well as all the meals aboard and while ashore. Guides carry a camera/phone and a dip net.

## YOU PROVIDE:

- **A 7 DAY NON-RESIDENT FISHING LICENSE:** online at [www.state.ak.us](http://www.state.ak.us). (Make sure the dates for fishing match the dates on your contract.)
- **FLYRODS:** We recommend that each fisherman brings two or three rods apiece. Single handed rods match our rivers best.
  - 7-9 wt. Rods are recommended for Steelhead and Silvers.
  - 9-10 wt. Rods are recommended for Chum Salmon.
  - 5-6 wt. Rods are recommended for Pink Salmon.

It is possible to use an 8 wt. Switch Rod on certain rivers for Steelhead. Please inquire if this is a good match for your trip

- **FLYLINES:** Typically floating lines work best. On occasion of high water a sink tip line cut back to 3-6' of the weighted portion can be of use.
- **WADERS AND COATS:** We use Simms G4 waders below and a Grunden's raincoat or Gore Tex above. Bring a couple sets of long johns as well a wool socks. ***Wading Shoes need to be vibram soled as FELTS ARE NOT ALLOWED in Alaska waters.***
- **GLOVES AND CAP**
- **HEADLAMP AND SPARE BATTERIES**
- **BOAT SLIPPER**
